What is IPA4SME?

Boosting the use of Intellectual Property with an action specifically designed for innovative European SMEs

- Sectors that use IP rights intensively account for 39% of the EU's economic output (GDP) and 35% of the employment
- Companies that own registered IP rights perform
 better economically than companies that do not
- The majority of European SMEs consider themselves as innovative, only 9 % of them register IP Rights







Top 3 reasons why SMEs do not protect their innovations:

- 1. Not seeing any benefit (*micro SMEs*)
- 2. Lack of knowledge on how to protect (small)
- 3. Costs of procedures (all)

Whilst medium-sized state that their intellectual assets are not innovative enough.





What services to we offer?

Financial and expert support for IP valorization and protection services to SMEs which have received a **Seal of Excellence** from the H2020 SME Instrument program, worth up to 15.000 EUR.

- IP Pre-diagnostic (Service1): Free of charge expert analysis of SMEs' existing technology and knowledge assets along with a customized IP business strategy.
- IP Protection Co-financing (Service 2/Service 3): Partial reimbursement of the costs associated with the IP registration process.





What services to we offer?

IP protection co-financing

- <u>EPO fee reimbursement (Service 2)</u>: For each EPO patent application, beneficiaries will receive **75% of the corresponding EPO fee** with a limit of **2.500 EUR** per patent application. There is a limit of 5 services of this type per SME.
- <u>IP attorney fee reimbursement (Service 3)</u>: For each patent application process beneficiaries will receive **50% of their IP attorney costs up to 2.000 EUR**. The IP attorneys must be entitled to act before the EPO.





Applicant SMEs must fulfil the following requirements:

- Be holder of a Seal of Excellence awarded in the context of the H2020 SME instrument. The Seal of Excellence must have been awarded to the SME in the three years prior to the call cut-off date.
- Meet the criteria to be considered an **SME** by the European Commission.
- All EU and COSME countries are eligible for IP Protection Cofinancing.
- To be eligible for IP Pre-diagnostics, SMEs must be incorporated in one of the following countries: Austria, Denmark, France, Germany, Greece, Ireland, Italy, Latvia, Netherlands, Spain, and Sweden.
- Have not been supported by the H2020 SME Instrument Phase 2 programme









Results of the 1st cut-off date
