- Cascade funding, or also known as Financial Support for Third Parties (FSTP), is a European Commission mechanism that distributes smaller amounts of public funds in a more agile way, supporting specific topics such as the incorporation of new technologies, the promotion of start-ups and sector pioneers, etc.
- The main objective of this funding method is to simplify administrative procedures for applicant entities, mostly SMEs and start-ups, thus allowing some EU-funded projects to issue, in turn, open calls for further funding. In other words, cascade funding is a simplified public funding opportunity, designed to facilitate a greater capillarity of European Commission funds and actions, facilitating the participation of SMEs and start-ups, since for them, participating in a European project means dealing with a large amount of bureaucracy.










ELBE Eurocluster

Principales actividades



Innovation support scheme, including an innovation challenge and innovation individual services for SMEs (1 + 2 calls)



Specific training courses in the areas of digitalisation, sustainability or business modelling (2 calls)



One internationalisation mission per year to emerging ORE markets such as South Korea, Australia or Brazil (3 calls)



Networking events to communicate about ELBE and its activities, for example in the framework of main conferences (WindEurope, FOWT, etc.)

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2. Innovation Individual services

One call in which one SME together with its provider will be able to apply among a portfolio of 5 services.

22-28 support of **€10,000** each

First call: **Closed on March 8** Second call: **To open in April-May**



Tipology of support	Objective
Access to test facilities	Provide easier access to existing labs or test-sites which are necessary for the completion of tests
International development	Support on building tailored identity shaping, implementing business agreements and joint collaborative projects
Market and business intelligence	Support can be (but is not limited to): reducing regulatory burden, providing access to market information, bottom- up analysis to identify vulnerable products/services, identification of the reasons for dependency on critical inputs, technologies, or infrastructures.
Development and tech transfer	Support on assessing the transferability potential of some technology to another sector or solve a technical problem to enable technology transfer
Green and IT Technology expertise	Support from DIH and other providers to SMEs in their green and digital transition to improve their energy resource efficiency, progress in the IT transition and in IT based smart manufacturing






3. Training

20 supports of **€13,500** each

First call: **Closed in November 2023** Second call: **To open in 2024 2S**







4. Internationalisation

Three (one per year) joint missions to emerging countries in ORE technologies beyond Europe

45 supports of **€1,000 - €3,000** each.

First call: **South Korea** Second call: **UK, USA and Australia (to open in mid-May)** Third call: **TBD**
